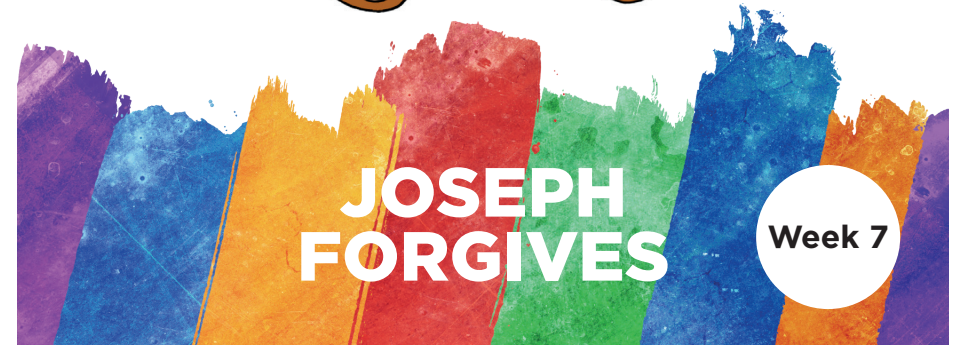

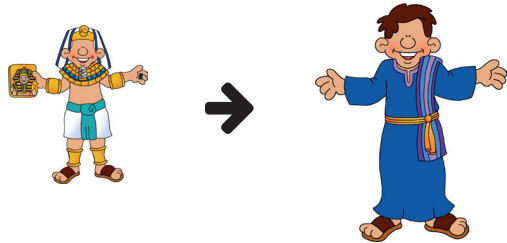

Who is being forgiven? What is being forgiven? Why is it important that forgiveness takes place?

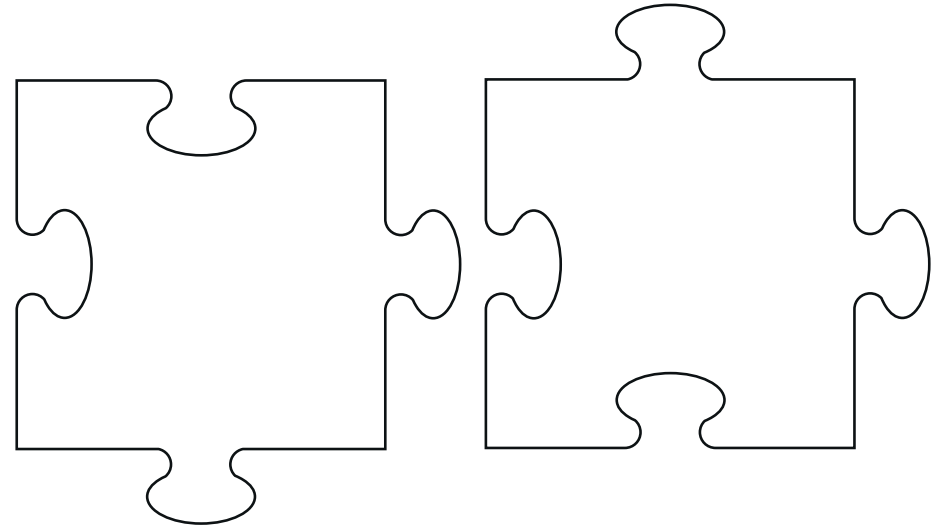
The man and his mat: Mark 2:1-12
